Campus Recycling Tips



Campus Wide Responsibilities

For recycling to be effective on campus it must be an effort on everyone's part. Here is list of materials that can be recycled. There is no sorting required. If it is not listed below it is not recyclable.



Co-Mingling of Recyclables

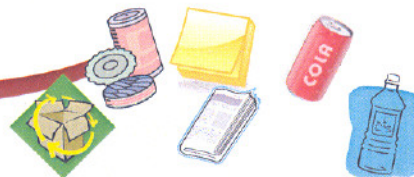
- **PAPER/CARDBOARD PRODUCTS** - Window envelopes, Fax Paper, Magazines, Junk Mail, Computer Paper, Shredded Paper, Telephone Books, Blue Prints, White Paper, Newspaper, Post-its, Paper with Staples, Cardboard, NCR Paper, Cores with tape,
- **ALUMINUM AND TIN** - Aluminum Cans, Clean Tin Cans,
- **PLASTIC PRODUCTS** -Plastic Film, Plastic Buckets, Aseptic Containers, Plastic Beverage Containers, Plastic Jugs, Plastic Bags,
- **REMEMBER - NO GARBAGE IN THE RECYCLING CONTAINERS!**



Location of Recycling Dumpsters around Campus

There are several locations around campus that have the large recycling dumpsters. Here are the locations:

- **Roberts Campus Center (Bldg I.)** - 3, four (4) cubic yard dumpsters - dumped once a week on Fridays
- **Business Technology Building (Bldg. H)/DeMoss Building (Bldg. J)** - 1, four (4) cubic yard dumpster - dumped once a week on Fridays.
- **Anderson Building (Bldg. F)** - 2, four (4) cubic yard dumpsters - dumped once a week on Fridays
- **Facilities/ECC Building (Bldg. N)** - 1, one (1) cubic yard dumpster - dumped every other week on Fridays.
- **Old Courthouse** - 1, one (1) cubic yard dumpster - dumped every other week on Fridays



CUSTODIAL DUTIES -

To collect all recyclables from appropriate containers and deposit it regularly into the recycling dumpsters. This includes all unsorted paper, cardboard, plastic, plastic bottles, and aluminum cans. **Glass is not recycled.**



RECYCLING VOLUNTEERS -

Will help in the following areas:

- Educating users on recycling procedures.
- Monitoring if garbage goes into recycling, and if recycling goes into garbage.
- Monitoring effectiveness of recycling program.
