This full-day workshop focuses on providing
the background information needed to pass the
Green Associate exam. This course is

general LEED processes and requirements.
Passing the Green Associate exam is a
prerequisite for the LEED specialization
exams; it is also the first step in becoming a
LEED AP. Participants will learn through a
variety of interactive exercises, lectures,
discussions, and quizzes.
