

Quick Reference: Placement into ENGL& 101 English Composition

ENGL& 101 English Composition is one of the key transfer classes in Washington state. You can enroll in this class if you have a 2.0 or better in COMP 100 (a prerequisite class), or you can look at placement options.

- We have a free <u>Directed Self-Placement (DSP) survey</u> for English in General Education. You answer questions, get suggestions, look at some sample class assignments, and then choose the English class that you want to take. That's right! The choice is 100% yours.
- You may be able to skip that survey and use high school grades or exam scores instead.
